the TSI if you have a score that does not meet the following benchmarks.

TSI

Reading and writing exemption score of 945 OR an Essay 4+ OR less than 944 with a diagnostic of 5+ & Essay of 5+

Math exemption score of 950 OR a Diagnostic of 6+

ACT

(Tested 2/14/23 or before) *Reading and Writing Exemption*- Composite of 23 <u>and</u> 19 in English (Tested 2/15/23 and after) Composite of 23 and 19 in English <u>OR</u> English <u>and</u> Reading combined score of 40+

(Tested 2/14/23 or before) Composite of 23 and Math 19+ (Tested 2/15/23 and after) Composite score of 22

SAT

Reading and Writing Exemption- **(SAT administered after to March 5,2016)** Minimum score of 480 in the Evidence-Based Reading and Writing (EBRW) test.

Math Exemption- (SAT administered after to March 5,2016) Minimum score of 530 on the mathematics test.

Transfer Student or Completed Degree

Earned associate or baccalaureate degree from an institution of higher education Transfers to an institution from a public, private or independent institution of higher education or an accredited out-of-state institution of higher education and who has satisfactorily completed college-level coursework as determined by UNT Dallas. A student who has previously attended any institution and has been determined to have met readiness standards by that institution.

Military or National Guard Service

Active duty as a member of the armed forces of the United States, the Texas National Guard, or a member of a reserve component of the armed forces of the United States and has been serving for at least 3 years preceding enrollment. (Please submit a letter from your commanding officer that includes enlisting date and valid current military ID).

A student who on or after August 1, 1990, was honorably discharged, retired, or released from active duty as a member of the armed forces of the United States or the Texas National Guard or service as a member of a reserve component of the armed forces of the United States. (Please submit a copy of your DD-214)

Texas College Bridge
