Majors: Public Health, Sociology, Pre-Med, Urban Ecology, Biology

Focus: Environmental toxins, mineral deficiencies, and chronic illness links.

Public Health Communications & Media

Majors: Digital/Radio Broadcasting, Public Health, Sociology

Focus: Educational media addressing food and health disparities in urban communities. Responsibilities: Canva/PowerPoint slide creation; Social media posts and scriptwriting; Digital storytelling projects.

Health Education & Curriculum Development Intern

Majors: Education, Public Health, Sociology

Focus: Food systems, disease prevention, and environmental health learning modules. Responsibilities: Curriculum drafting and presentation creation; Feedback collection via surveys.
