

ABOUT THE PROGRAM

The M.Ed. in Educational Leadership is designed for educators who desire to participate in a robust academic program grounded in the knowledge of current research and the application of real-life experiences. The engaging course of study aims to develop leaders that can effectively meet challenges and present rich opportunities that schools need and students deserve. Within the program, aspiring leaders can engage in design thinking to solve complex problems that require competency in instructional leadership, human capital, executive leadership, school culture, and strategic operations. A supervised internship is required. The internship provides aspiring leaders with rigorous, authentic, and quality training with a practicing school administrator.

Students completing all requirements for the M.Ed. in Educational Leadership, including the internship, and passing the TEXES Principal Exams and approval of submitted teacher service records will be eligible for the Texas Principal Certificate. The 30-semester hour program prepares students with the skills and knowledge required for leadership careers at campus and central office administration positions.
