ECHS v. General Admissions Application

- General admissions application for Fall 2021 is degree seeking (4 year Bachelor's degree)
- ECHS admissions application is non-degree seeking
- General admissions app you must select a major and minor, ECHS admissions app you selected a career pathway

What is ApplyTexas?

- ApplyTexas was created to provide a centralized means for both Texas and non-Texas students to apply to various institutions available through Apply Texas.
- Most Texas college and universities offer their admissions applications via ApplyTexas

DON'T MEET AUTOMATIC ADMISSIONS REQUIREMENTS?

Your application will be evaluated holistically based on the following factors:

- Strength of academic background (rigor of graduation plan, GPA, rank, etc.)
- Academic course selection (including dual credit, honors, AP and IB courses)
- Extracurricular activities
- Leadership experiences
- Community service
- Special achievements, honors, and awards
- Employment and internship experience
- Personal statement/Essay
- Two letters of recommendation
- First-Generation in College status
- Other special circumstances that put your academic and personal background into context



UNT Dallas Admission Key Dates

- Application and Documents for Fall 2021 must be submitted by- **December 1st, 2020**
- First Day of Fall 2021- **Monday, August 23rd, 2021**

Financial Aid Key Dates

UNT Dallas Scholarship Priority Deadline

- Must be **ADMITTED** by **December 1, 2020** for priority scholarship consideration
- Must **APPLY** by **March 15, 2021** for final scholarship consideration

UNT Dallas TASFA/FASFA

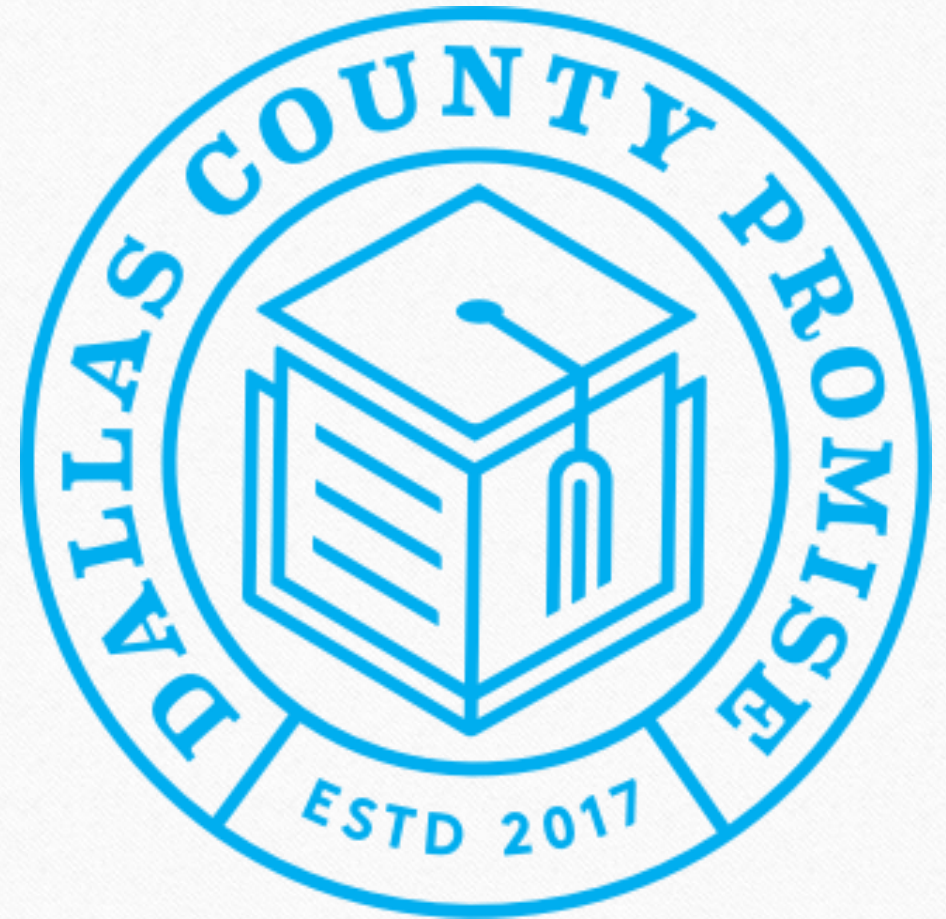

- Dallas County Promise is a last-dollar tuition scholarship that will cover the gap between state and federal aid and the cost of classes

- Promise Partner College
- Complete pledge at **DallasCountyPromise.org**
- Apply soon! Deadline: February 5, 2021

NOTE: Program does NOT cover student fees, housing, books and other expense



Transferring Credits

- Credit received through Dallas College is transferrable to UNT Dallas
- Credit received through UNT Dallas under the ECHS is deemed transferable to other Texas universities
- If uncertain about certain course being transferable to a university be sure to reach the appropriate admissions point of contact.
- The credit received at UNT Dallas will be counted as university credit upon your high school graduation
