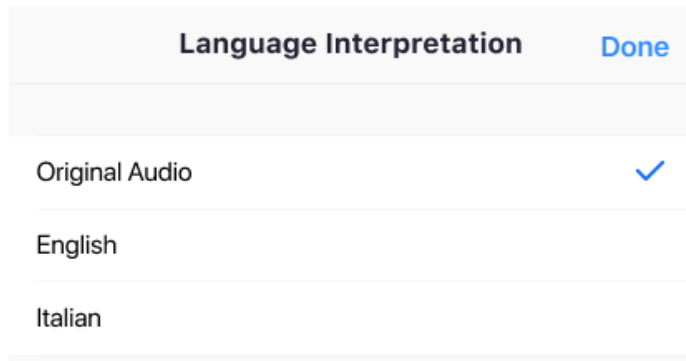

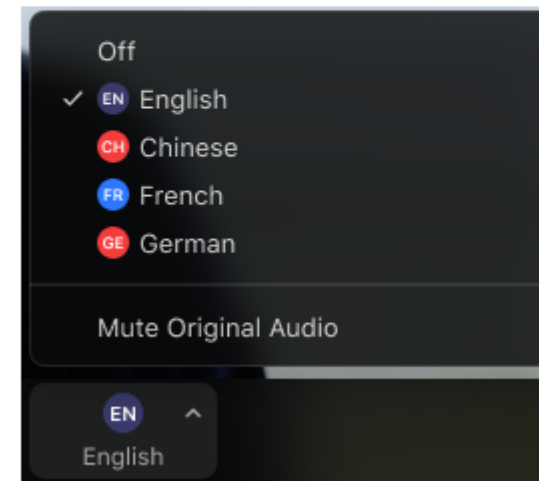

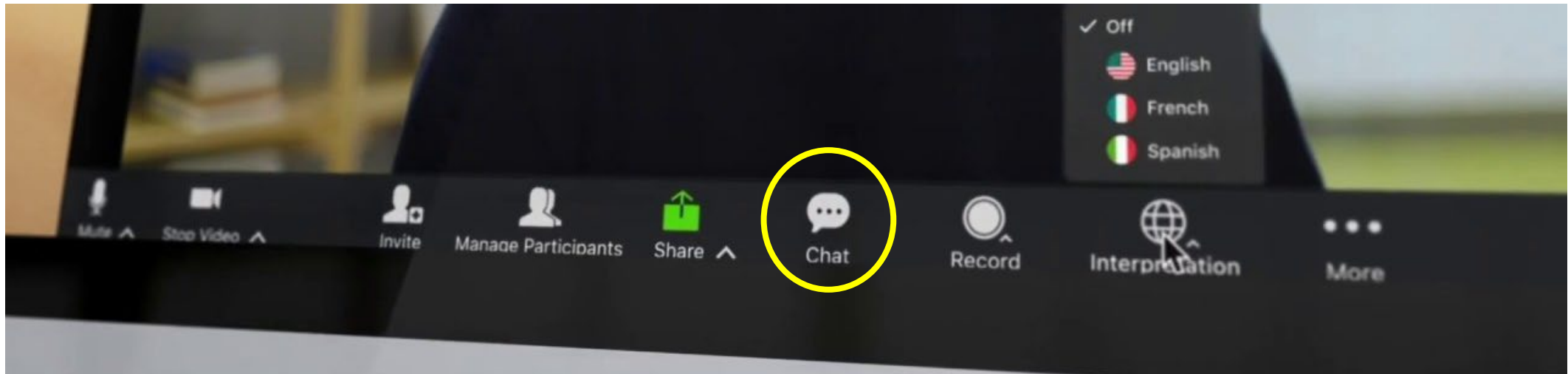

Fall 2020 Remote Learning



The first class is SYNCHRONOUS – students need to log-in and attend on the scheduled day/time.

Canvas, Microsoft Teams, and Zoom are the most used platforms.

Format of Classes

Three Scenarios:

Synchronous: students log in for class at the set day/time for every class session.

Asynchronous: students access lectures and readings posted weekly on their own schedule.

Hybrid: students mostly access material on their own schedule with some class sessions together.

RECOMMENDED

A student works on a class when the class is scheduled – regardless of format.

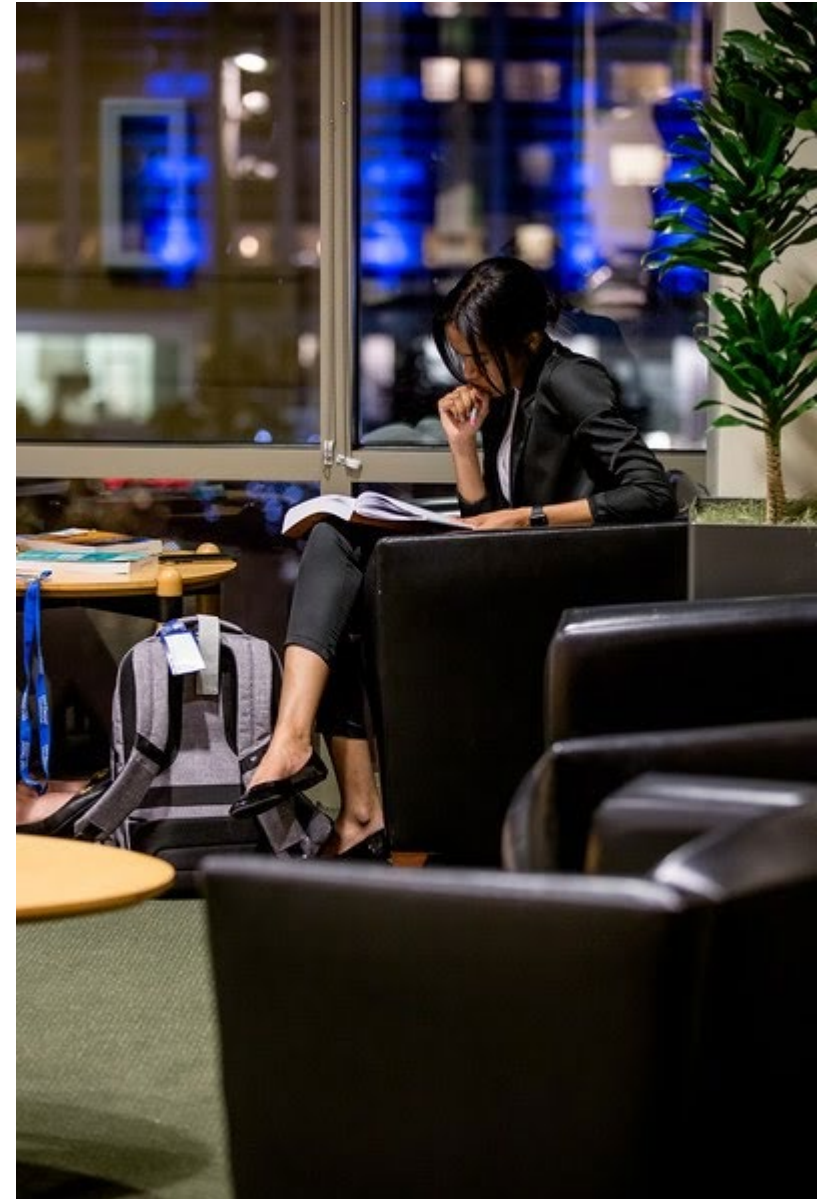

Block Schedules

Enrolled in classes alongside the general student population between **8:30-3:50**. Schedules cannot be changed in this structured course pathway.



Supplemental Instruction*

Students have access to SI for difficult courses. Attendance records will be shared with DISD Administrators.



College Success Hour*

Students will have 60 min/weekly of additional support around college success and college application process – mirroring UGST content.

Dallas ISD School teams will also check attendance daily, provide weekly progress monitoring, and support students to organize study groups.

Through this unique collaboration, Lincoln B-TECH and Sunset P-TECH students take their senior-year classes on the UNT Dallas campus. Students are afforded the opportunity to earn up to 60 college credit hours tuition-free while in high school, creating a pathway to achieve a bachelor's degree in just two years after graduating high school.

Why Early College High School?

The University of North Texas at Dallas is proud to be the only four-year university in Texas to partner with Early College High Schools (ECHS). This unique collaboration is the perfect blending of innovation on the high school level and UNT Dallas' mission to provide urban Dallas students with a clear vision and pathway to a bachelor's degree and lifelong socioeconomic mobility.

What are the benefits of Early College High School?

ECHS students earn both their high school diploma and a two-year associate's degree -- up to 60 credit hours to apply toward a bachelor's degree -- by the time they graduate high school, saving students both time and money. ECHS also eases the transition to college life by bringing students onto the UNT Dallas campus and into its classrooms to take all of their senior-year courses. Following high school graduation, students will be positioned to graduate with a UNT Dallas bachelor's degree in two years, and fully prepared to enter a rewarding career.

What is a P-TECH/B-TECH?

Early College High Schools allow students to focus their studies on specialized career paths: P-TECH stands for "Pathways in Technology;" and B-TECH stands for "Pathways in Business Technology." Both programs afford motivated students the ability to choose a specific career track and take courses that provide the academic, technical and workplace skills desired by employers. These programs also partner with industry leaders who mentor, advise on coursework, enhance skill development and initiate access to internships that will prepare students for careers after college. 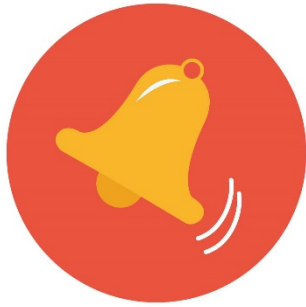

Procedure for Accommodations

1. Complete the Request for Disability Accommodations form

- <https://sa.untDallas.edu/disability-services>
- Include documentation (current within last three years), including actual test results

2. Submit the Request for Disability Accommodations form with documentation

- Email untddisability@untDallas.edu and include your ECHS Counselor
- Include available times and dates to meet (at least 3)

3. Meet with Office of Disability Services on Microsoft Teams to discuss accommodations

4. Office of Disability Services emails accommodation forms to instructor, student, and counselor.

- Student and instructor sign and return forms to Office of Disability Services.
- Student and ECHS Counselor will ensure parent receives communication at each stage

Student Responsibilities



- Communicate with Office of Disability Services **prior to mid-term and final exams** to discuss accommodations
- Requests for accommodations must be submitted each semester. Don't wait! **Submit your request for accommodations one month prior** to Spring semester
