

Lyman & Eloise Owen Memorial Scholarship Instructions – 2022-23

APPLICANT ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

- Meet the minimum academic performance standards of the university in effect at the time of the award;
- Must be graduating in May 2023 or after;
- Undergraduate applicants must be enrolled in at least 12 hours and have a 3.0 or better cumulative GPA on a 4.0 scale as a continuing UNT Dallas student;
- Graduate school applicants must be enrolled in at least 9 hours and have a 3.25 or better cumulative GPA on a 4.0 scale as a continuing UNT Dallas student;
- Applicants must submit an application along with an essay on the topic provided;
- Must submit two (2) letters of recommendation – one (1) from a professor/teacher and one (1) from an external individual with the application;
- Financial need, as determined by completion of the federal (FAFSA) or state (TASFA) financial aid applications.

TERMS OF SCHOLARSHIP:

A **one-time** scholarship of **\$2,000** will be awarded. This scholarship will be disbursed to the student as follows:

- Fall 2022 semester: \$1,000
- Spring 2023 semester: \$1,000

APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS:

You must complete and submit the following:

1. **Lyman & Eloise Owen Memorial Scholarship Application** – (see p. 2)
2. **Essay** – A written essay on the topic of “What I plan to do with my degree.” You may want to include information about your educational, career, and personal goals, as well as details about challenges you have faced. Please limit the essay to no more than two (2) typed pages. Include your name and title of the essay at the top of the paper.
3. **Personal Statement** – Please tell us more about who you are as a person, your background, what led you to UNT Dallas, your interests, other obstacles you have overcome or anything else you wish to share. Please explain your financial need within this statement.
4. **Recommendations** – (see separate attachment)
