Canvas – Attaching Rubric to Turnitin


Introduction:

This guide will cover how to attach a scoring rubric to an assignment that is utilizing Turnitin to check for academic integrity. **DO NOT** attempt to make these changes if students have already submitted work to Turnitin.

Attaching the Rubric First:

- 1) Create your assignment as you normally would in Canvas.
- 2) Select “Online” as the “Submission Type” for the assignment.
DO NOT select “External Tool”. You must attach the rubric **BEFORE** you attach Turnitin.

- 3) Follow the standard process for adding or attaching a scoring rubric found at [QSG \(Canvas – Creating a Scoring Rubric\)](#).
- 4) Press “Save” to save the assignment.
- 5) Click “Edit” button to edit the assignment.
- 6) Change the “Submission Type” to “External Tool” and follow the directions found at [QSG \(Turnitin – Assignment Setup\)](#).
- 7) Press “Save” to save the assignment.


Canvas – Attaching Rubric to Turnitin

Adding a Rubric After Turnitin was Setup:

This process outlines how to attach a rubric to an assignment if Turnitin was setup before the rubric as attached. **DO NOT** use this process if students have already submitted work to Turnitin for this assignment.

- 1) Open the assignment you want to attach the rubric to.
- 2) Click “Edit Assignment Settings” in the top-right corner.
- 3) Copy the URL for the External Tool Submission Type. You will need it in a later step.



- 4) Change the “Submission Type” from “External Tool” to “Online”.

- 5) Press “Save” to save the assignment.
- 6) Click “+ Rubric” button and follow process for adding or attaching a scoring rubric found at [QSG \(Canvas – Creating a Scoring Rubric\)](#).
- 7) Click “Edit” button to edit the assignment.
- 8) Change the “Submission Type” to “External Tool”.

9) Paste the URL you copied in Step 3 above into the URL field.

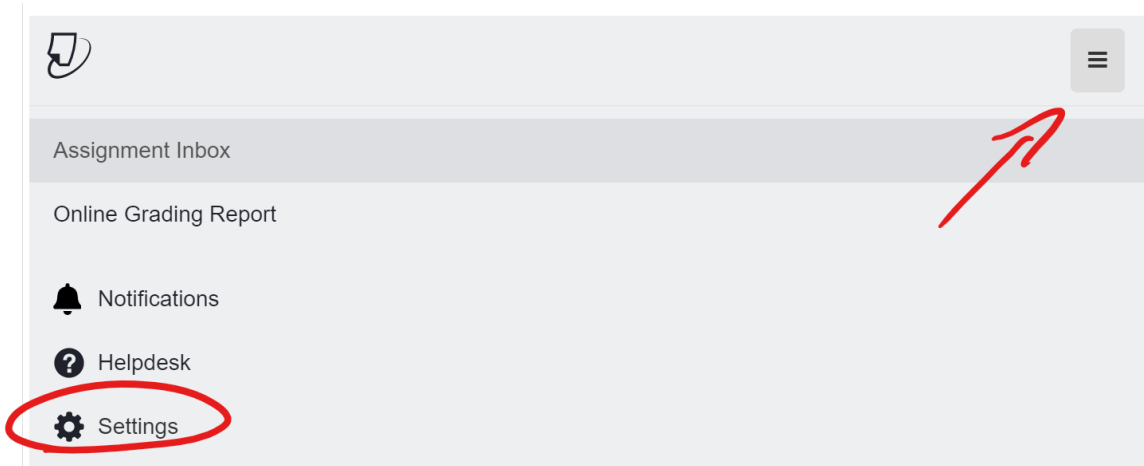

10) Press “Save” button to save the assignment.

11) Verify that the settings for Turnitin are as expected. Click menu and then select “Settings”.



12) Verify that the rubric is visible in the SpeedGrader™.
