Your child has indicated an interest and/or has been nominated to apply for selection to the Upward Bound (UB) Program at University of North Texas at Dallas. Upward Bound is a FREE college preparatory program for high school students funded by the U.S. Department of Education and sponsored locally by The University of North Texas at Dallas.

The ultimate goal of the UNT - Dallas TRIO Upward Bound Programs is to support the Academic, Emotional and Social Development of our students from High School through Collegiate Completion. Students identified for inclusion within our Upward Bound Programs should be students who have demonstrated a strong will to succeed in spite of their challenges with Academic Performance, Attendance and/or Lack of Collegiate History within their families. Upward Bound participants are students who are in need of Encouragement, Guidance and Support to meet and exceed their expected outcomes to become College Graduates prepared to make an impact within our Global Society.

Year-Round services provided by the UB Program of the University of North Texas at Dallas include:

- Saturday instruction in Math, Science, English and Foreign Language, including hands-on experience in laboratories, in computer facilities, and at field sites:
- A Six Week Summer Residential Instructional component that is designed to simulate a college-going experience that includes daily coursework in Math, Science, English and Foreign Language as well as other related activities such as Cultural Enrichment field trips and special events:
- Activities that involve participants with opportunities to learn from professionals who are engaged on campus, in governmental agencies, non-profits, community based agencies, or other public or private agencies:
- •Academic advising from UB staff and individual assistance with the college admissions and financial aid application process.

Academic Saturdays during the school year will take place at the University of North Texas at Dallas as well as the Six-Week Residential session (Summer Component) that takes place during summer.

Candidates considering our Upward Bound Program must be committed to their personal preparation for success within High School and Post-Secondary Education. Therefore, each candidate must accept the reality that they will be stretched beyond their current Academic Emotional and Social Levels to obtain extraordinary levels of success in their Personal and Professional Lives. **Please note that selected students and their parents must commit to remain active in the UB Program year round (12 months) for a minimum of 3 -4 years or until high school graduation**.

In order to comply with federal regulations, all UB participants must meet the following criteria:

- Indicate an interest in attending college;
- Demonstrate academic need (low grades and/or low test scores);
- Qualify as Low Income and/or Potential First Generation College Student (neither parent has received a 4-year college degree);
- Commit to remain active in UB until high school graduation
